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FULTON COUNTY MAN ARRESTED FOR INSURANCE FRAUD

Atlanta – Insurance Commissioner Ralph Hudgens announced today that a Fulton County man has been charged with one count of insurance fraud, one count of forgery and one count of identity fraud for allegedly presenting fraudulent documentation in order to receive insurance benefits.

Arrested on February 5, was Emanuel Daniel Lofton, 43, of Atlanta, Ga. Lofton was booked into the Fulton County Jail and was released on a \$13,500 bond on February 7.

An investigation by Hudgens' Fraud Investigation Division revealed that Lofton submitted a fraudulent Wage and Salary Verification Form to AIG Insurance Company in an attempt to obtain monies for loss income related to his alleged medical claim.

Insurance fraud is a felony punishable by imprisonment for two to ten years, or by a fine of up to \$10,000.00, or both.
